Report on the Financial Statements:

We have audited accompanying **consolidated** financial statements of **CENTRE FOR SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE** ("the Trust") H. No. 12-13-445, Street No.1, Tarnaka, Secunderabad -17, Telangana, which comprise Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2014 and annexed Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements:
